MINCE PIE APPLES
(no!! not the naughty mince pies)

Ingredients

3 Eating apples, such as Braeburn
40g Sultanas
20g Dried cranberries, finely chopped
1 Carrot, peeled and grated
1 Orange, zest only
½ Teaspoon Golden Syrup
½ Teaspoon Ground Cinnamon
15g Flaked Almonds
Pinch of Nutmeg

1. Preheat the oven to Gas 6 / 200c
2. Halve the apples and scoop out the core, plus a little of the apple flesh to create space for the filling. Lay the apple halves on a baking tray and roast for 10 minutes.
3. Meanwhile, mix together the sultanas, cranberries, carrot, orange zest, golden syrup and spices and set aside.
4. Remove the apples and scoop a tablespoon of the fruit mixture into each apple half. Sprinkle the flaked almonds over the apple halves and return to the oven for 15 minutes or until the apples are soft.
5. Serve immediately on their own or with low-fat natural yoghurt.

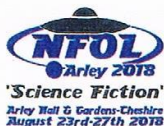

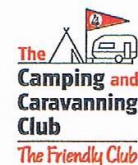
