Chairman's Welcome

It is strange how things pan out. I am a great believer in fate, being at a certain place at a certain time. Also, if you really want to do something, then you have to overcome your anxieties. This has happened this month. Colin & I have been staying at our daughter's house in France. Firstly, I have only ever been abroad for a week and this stay has been 3 weeks. I usually get itchy feet after a week.

My Son in Law's sister died in Wales. My family wanted to go to the funeral but really needed someone to look after my granddaughter, the house, gite business and two Welsh collies. Luckily, I changed my flight to stay on. They flew to Manchester the same day as Colin went back to Southampton.

The only problem was that I have never driven on the wrong side of the road (legally lol!). I had a couple of driving lessons with my daughter. I managed to drive them all to the airport & then my granddaughter & I back home. So, I have managed to help my family and gain a skill that I can be confident with next time. I also had a bit more time to practise my French.

I decided on Wednesday Beth's half day at school to take her out to Thouars waterfall. We had a lovely afternoon drive, walk and paddle in the water by the waterfall. It was very pretty. The surrounding area is similar to Cheddar Gorge. On the way back as the patisserie was closed, we stopped at Carrefour for some provisions including maltesers.

On Friday I decided to venture out on my own. I did a 42-mile round trip to visit the Camifolia Gardens at Chemille near Angers in the Maine De La Loire Region. The gardens are both educational & recreational. They have many school groups visiting to learn about plants used for aromatherapy, skin care & medicines. They had a large display/information area with products for sale including soaps, hand cream, oils & drinks. I bought some Camomile Romaine seeds to grow. With camomile you can make a relaxing tea.

The gardens are divided into different areas – Mediterranean Greenhouse, Local produce, medicine men, sensory, medicinal/toxic plants, fibre/dye & druggist's cabinet. There was also a very impressive triangular bug house one and a half metres wide, a tall Bee Way (hive) & an igloo shaped arbour made from willow with seating in.

France have banned insecticides & chemicals for personal use. Talking with a local he gave me the recipe for a natural weed killer (ONLY TO BE USED ON

WASTE GROUND OR PATHS – **NOT ON THE LAWN OR IN THE BORDER**). I am going to try this when I get home. You will need: -

1 litre of white vinegar

3 large spoons of salt

3 large spoons of washing up liquid.

A spray bottle.

Mix the salt into the vinegar until dissolved & stir and add washing up liquid.

Use on a sunny day about midday.

BAMPTON'S FARM – LYMINGTON

Thankfully the weatherman smiled on the 15 units (8 New Forest), that attended Bampton's Farm near Lyminster over the May Bank Holiday and thanks to the sunshine, and our stewards, Ian (Fraser) and Colin (Brown), we all enjoyed a very pleasant "chill out" weekend. Bampton's is a large flat field mostly surrounded by countryside and is a short distance from the Isle of Wight Ferry Port and the Farm's own Pick-Your-Own Strawberry Farm which is well worth a visit! It also has a café and a large children's activity area. Apart from a trip into Lyminster and the Quay, Ray and I also found two interesting places to visit not too far away.

The first place was Apple Court Garden in Hordle (SO41 OHU). It covers one acre and was formed in 1980 from an old walled garden. It has several different gardens to walk through including a Japanese Garden with huge fish! Tea, Coffee and cake are available and are served in the summer house overlooking an Italian type garden. It has a small plant selection which you can purchase. Apple Court is open 10-4 Wednesday to Sunday, May to September and cost £5 to go in.

Our second "find" was Setley Ridge Vineyard just south of Brockenhurst (SO42 7UF). The owners grow the grapes and make their own wine. There is also a garden centre, a lovely café/restaurant also with outdoor seating and a shop selling wine, vegetables, jams, chutneys, cake etc etc.

So! if you are ever either, in, or camping in the area, do give these two places a try, we thoroughly enjoyed them.

DOWNTON CUCKOO FAIR 2019

Well, the sun shone and ... yes, the wind did blow ... in fact we didn't know where it was coming from, but we sure knew where it was going!! The weatherman said it was going to be colder than Easter, and he was right!! But never mind, that didn't deter the crowds or the enthusiasm of about 20,000 people who gathered in the centre of Downton for the 40th Anniversary of the Fair. There was entertainment, a 100 or more stalls of every kind, Charity stalls, Country Crafts and animals, all sorts of places to eat and drink, Maypole dancing and a parade with the Downton Cuckoo Queen.

Village Fairs in Downton can be traced back to the 11th Century. By the 1530's the Spring Fair had been called the Cuckoo Fair, at which a Cuckoo King was crowned. By the beginning of the 20th Century, the Fair was used for hiring labour and selling livestock as well as for festivities. The last such fair was held in 1920. In 1980, a group of villagers planned a regeneration of the Fair in the centre on the Moot, but including a Craft Fair and Maypole Dancing in the area of the street called The Borough. Over the years the Fair has grown and has raised over £1 million pounds for local groups since 1980.

Our New Forest D.A. runs a Meet over the whole of the early May Bank Holiday weekend in conjunction with the Fair which is very close by, in fact in walking distance from our camp site. So, if you fancy a trip to the 41st Downton Cuckoo Fair, early May Bank Holiday 2020, then why not make a note in your camping calendar right now and come along to our Meet and enjoy a great event!!
