- Be available on site in case members need help
- Check the site is clean as you take down the signs
- Be the last person to leave

What you get from being a steward

- You get free camping for the weekend
- The DA will offer to pay a fee towards your travel expenses
- You get to meet loads of new people and make new friends
- Have an enjoyable and memorable weekend
- You get that great feeling to know that you have done your bit to keep the DA going. Without you, there wouldn't be a meet

Your Temporary Holiday Sites

Birchwood Tourist Park starts on June 8th 2022 and ends on July 6th. The cost including your ehu and use of all facilities is only £16.50 pun. I have already had many requests for pitches since Christmas so if any of you wish to reserve places you do need to get your requests in to me as quickly as possible.



NEW FOR 2022

Holme Bush Inn, Corfe Mullen 4th August to 1st Sept

Only £10.50pun. The site is behind The Holme Bush Inn at Corfe Mullen so there is great potential for them as with a pub on site which also serves meals this could bring them much needed extra income. The new owner is very excited at the prospect of hosting his first THS on this site. Access is easy from the road, through the carpark and then



along a track into the field. It will be quiet apart from the odd afternoon when the owner plans to have some live musical entertainment. Note this is afternoon not evening as he is keen not to upset any of his neighbours.

There is also a neighbouring field where dogs can be walked but don't forget doggie bags please, as children also could use this field to play games and if we have visiting youth again they can have a tent camp in there too. I have had offers of help for all 4 weeks so thank you to the 2 couples who have volunteered.

Birchwood is already booked for 2023 in September. Hopefully we will return to Holme Bush in August 2023 as we have asked for first refusal and said it will be subject to results this year

Sites News February 2022

As this edition of Pickets Post gets sent out, we are getting ready for our "Early Bird" meet on February the 17th at Birchwood Tourist Park near Wareham. This meet is being stewarded by Tim Cooper our Treasurer and his lovely partner Helen, as their first meet. Such a lovely site, with direct access to Wareham Forest for walking, cycling and exercising your dogs. The meet also benefits from having electric hook up, on-site showers & toilets, washing machines, a children's play area and even dedicated dog showers for those mucky pups. No wonder it is a firm favourite with members.

I am still working daily on increasing the number of rallies for this year, trying new venues, but keeping the regular favourites. So something in the calendar for everyone really. I hope to find another site to squeeze into the schedule for March before the AGM, but many sites don't open till easter. So watch this space

A returning site this year is Mill Paddock at East Stoke near Wareham. The DA has not visited this site since about 2015, so a lot has changed, with improvements to the facilities. Hopefully you will all like it. Another new site to us is Stonehenge Campsite, a beautiful little site just 10 minutes from the world heritage stones themselves. It is also within walking distance of a country pub well thought of for it's food offerings. We are also hosting a meet for the Bournemouth Airshow weekend at the Homestead Parley again

Another new meet is going to be something of an oddity for us. We have booked a rally in countryside right by a Bournemouth bus route, at Yeomans Way at Throop. Basically behind Castle Point shopping centre, but far enough away to be away in the van enjoying some lovely local sunshine. There are toilets and showers on the site, but no hook up. Perfect for meeting up with friends and taking in a show or a meal in Bournemouth town centre.

The list of sites is on the next page, and as you will see, we need some volunteer stewards to run several meets please. The role of steward may sound daunting, but seriously, it is very easy and great fun. We ask that you get to the site early, maybe the night before. Be there to welcome campers and take payment via card on our device. As simple as using a calculator and we will of course show you how. Keep a record of any campers, and their details. Be on site in case of emergencies (for insurance reasons) and to assist campers with any questions. Ensure the meet closes on time and the field/pitches are left clean. It really is that simple, advice and training is available if required. Plus, there is always the "stewards manual" in the stewards kit and plenty of advice from other members if needed.

In return for you sharing your weekend, we give you the weekend's camping FREE and provide a mileage fee to cover your travel. Plus you get to meet and chat with loads of new people, who you may not otherwise get to meet. Campers are on the whole, a VERY friendly sociable group. We have made many life long friends when stewarding meets.


