Recipe for Lemon cheesecake

This was made by Erin Arnold one of the New Forest DA's

Youth members at the Easter meet.

Ingredients

75g butter

170g digestive biscuits

200ml double cream

300g condensed milk

2 medium lemons

You will also need a cheesecake dish, electronic whisk, grater, bowl, lemon juicer, rolling pin.

First melt the butter and as it is melting place the digestive biscuits into a sandwich bag and then re bag.

Carefully crush biscuits with rolling pin. After they are crushed, mix with the butter to form the base. Then evenly spread the mixture out into the cheesecake dish.

Place the double cream in the bowl & using the whisk, mix the cream until light and gluggy.

Add the condensed milk into the bowl & mix together. Juice and zest the lemons & add both into the bowl & mix (You should notice that it starts to turn fluffy).

Now add the mixture to the dish. Leave it to set overnight in the fridge.

The site is behind The Holme Bush Inn at Corfe Mullen so there is great potential for them as with a pub on site which also serves meals this could bring them much needed extra income. The new owner is very excited at the prospect of hosting his first THS on this site. Access is easy from the road, through the carpark and then along a track into the field. It will be quiet apart from the odd afternoon when the owner plans to have some live musical entertainment I was out there this week and so

far on the calendar playing on:- 3rd Aug are 20th Century Boys 10th Aug are Beginners Luck .

17th Aug are Absolute Block and 24th Aug Lady Winwoods Maggot. Hopefully it will be dry and this will take place outside on the patio area. I take place outside on the patio area

We took the opportunity to have a meal whilst out there and I must say I only had a main course and found that almost too large to get through. We had a lovely

Hunter's Chicken with Salad and chips which was the Special Offer of the Day and was all cooked to order. We also saw some delicious looking jacket potatoes on another table.

They do have some theme days so normally Tuesday evening is Quiz Night and Friday is card Bingo.



Sunday Lunches at the moment are

£12.95 for 2 meats, vegetables and Yorkshire Pudding with a Nut roast available also at the same price, but like everyone is finding, the cost of food is increasing so I cannot guarantee that this price will hold until Aug.

I was also impressed with the progress made so far with the site considering we have had winter since I was there. A new Elsan area has been provided, and extra water taps. The grass is already being cut so that it is hopefully nice by he time we go in Aug. This coming week the hedge between the 2 main fields is being removed which will give us easier access. I have met with the groundsman and also some of the pub staff so it is slowly becoming somewhere we are looking forward to being. All we need now are the visitors to make it a successful event.

I have received some complaints about camping at Breamore and Wareham RUFC. I can assure you all that I have investigated these complaints and can confirm that camping is still not allowed at either site even though it has happened. Both landowners are seeking an appeal and I understand that this may be allowed but with mitigation costs to us. If the cost is anything like the cost at Ballard School then it will be untenable as it would make the sites very expensive. I am in touch with both landowners.

It was not the Camping and Caravanning Club who were camping as all our requests go via our headquarters to the council and then we get either a confirmation or an objection. I hope this answers those of you who have questioned what is going on and reassures you all that we are keeping in touch with the current situation.

Sites News June 2022

Sadly, we have been forced to cancel the Throop rally, as despite requests, not a single member offered to steward the meet. We also had no interest shown for anyone to attend the meet, which is rather sad.

A similar story with the Mill Paddock meet, which although we had a steward, we had zero interest from members. So we have changed the venue to Warren Park farm in Alderholt, which is always a firm favourite and has a few electric hookups.

Our Stone Henge Campsite meet has had to be replaced due to technical difficulties. For this meet, we have arranged Orchard Farm Chidham, which is near Chichester. A beautiful little site within walking distance of a pub and Bosham. This site also benefits from some electric hook ups

ARE YOU CONFUSED BY WHAT YOU CAN USE ON A CAMPSITE ELECTRIC HOOK UP?

First of all, do not take large wattage kettles, toasters etc from home. Try to use low watt alternatives.

DIVIDE THE APPLIANCE WATTAGE BY THE VOLTS TO GIVE THE AMPS. IF ON A LOW AMP OR SHARED/SPLIT HOOK-UP, TURN SOMETHING OFF BEFORE SWITCHING SOMETHING ON. I.E. SWITCH YOUR WATER HEATER OFF BEFORE USING TOASTER.

Think only 1 heating element at a time. Switch off 1 before using another.

Examples of amps conversion.

Toaster 1300w = 5.6 amps

Microwave 1000w = 4.3 amps

Small Air Fryer 1000w = 4.3 amps

Colour T.V. 130w = 0.4-1.3 amps

Hairdryer 300w = 1.3 amps (most hairdryers are at least 1000W!)

Truma heater half load 1000 = 4.2 amp

Truma water heater = 2.7 amp

Laptop Charger 80w = 0.4 amp

Our Easter meet at Warren Park Farm Alderholt has only a very limited number of hookups so these will be shared and so only 5 amp




