Your Temporary Holiday Sites – Autumn 2022

I am pleased to update you all on current situation with regard to Temporary Holiday Sites.

Breamore say camping in 2023 is unlikely.

The Rugby Club at Wareham are still hopeful and I am in touch with them to keep abreast of what is going on there.

Birchwood is on in September and booked. I have already had over 20 requests to reserve pitches as frequent visitors are eager to ensure they have a pitch.

Holme Bush are suggesting that we go to them in June next year. (I certainly would not be recommending a return in August or at any other time when they have major functions in their other fields. This is a large site with 6 paddocks apart from their certificated location. There were teething problems but nothing that cannot be fixed during the coming year. The musical events were all free to our members and, on the whole. were very good. We also had a Morris Dance display.

Your Committee will now be discussing Holme Bush along with other suggestions for 2023 such as Moor Farm, Chickerell for which I have had 1 volunteer to steward.

Lymington has also been suggested as a possible venue. My thoughts are to run each one of these for 2 full weeks but 3 weekends rather than a full 28 days. In order to do this I do urgently need offers of stewards for each site. Without these there is little point in organising as there is no way I can cope with doing all of them. It is now time for other members to come forward and help to raise the funds for the DA to function. All your paperwork and site signage will be provided with lots of support but I do need able bodies on the field to do that side of things.

Any offers of help with stewarding for 2023 please let me know. No help = no THS = no income for the DA = no treats for you the member. Looking at June, July, Aug & Sept.
