



I am pleased to update you all on current situation with regard to Temporary Holiday Sites.

The Rugby Club at Wareham is still hopeful for 2023. I have had a reply from Natural England and sent them the extra information they requested including a photograph of the part of the site that we use. I am now waiting a response once more but am still hopeful of success for this site in August.

Birchwood is on in September and booked. I have already had over 20 requests to reserve pitches as frequent visitors are eager to ensure they have a pitch. Cost for 2023 will be £18 pun.

Holme Bush have contacted me and we are going to talk again in March as I am still uncertain about going ahead with a booking for this site. I have had 1 volunteer to steward but I want to be certain that work has been done to improve things before going ahead.

Moor Farm, Chickerell for which I have had 1 volunteer to steward is still a possibility in place of Holme Bush. June/July


Lymington was suggested as a possible venue but unfortunately both sites there are fully booked for summer 2023.

SUNDAY 12 January 10.15 for 10.30 is our next date. Please follow the signs. Details as before or ring me on 01202 485832 for info.


